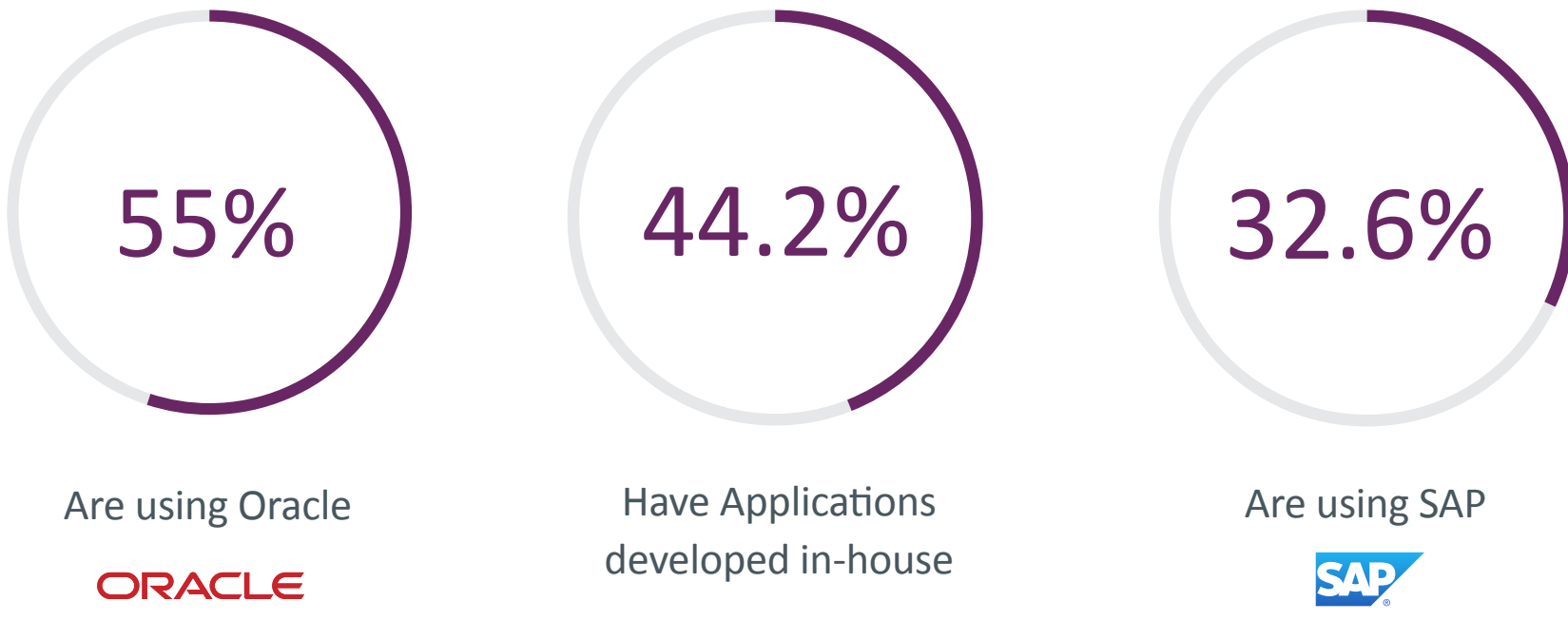

Ensono commissioned a survey of 130 organisations running IBM i to find out how organisations are dealing with this vital business platform: Here are 5 key findings summarised below.

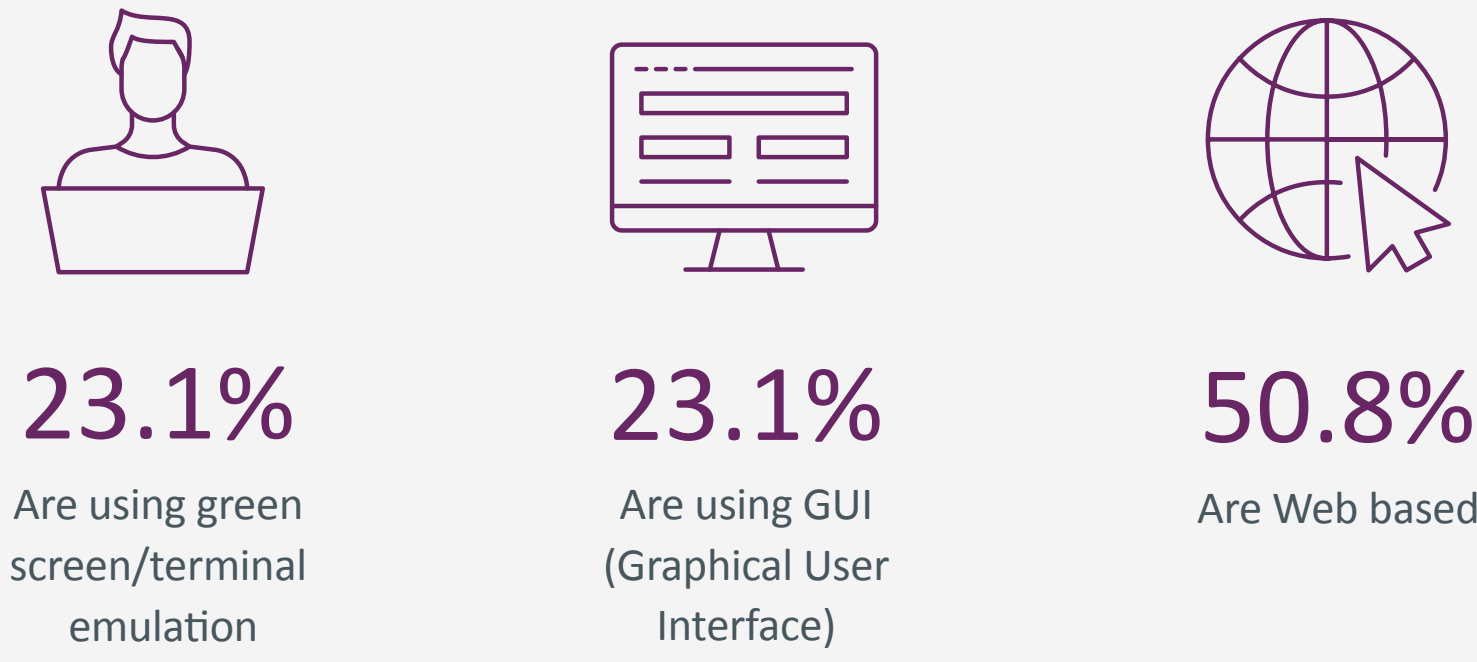
1. IBM i continues to be important with many business-critical applications running on the platform:



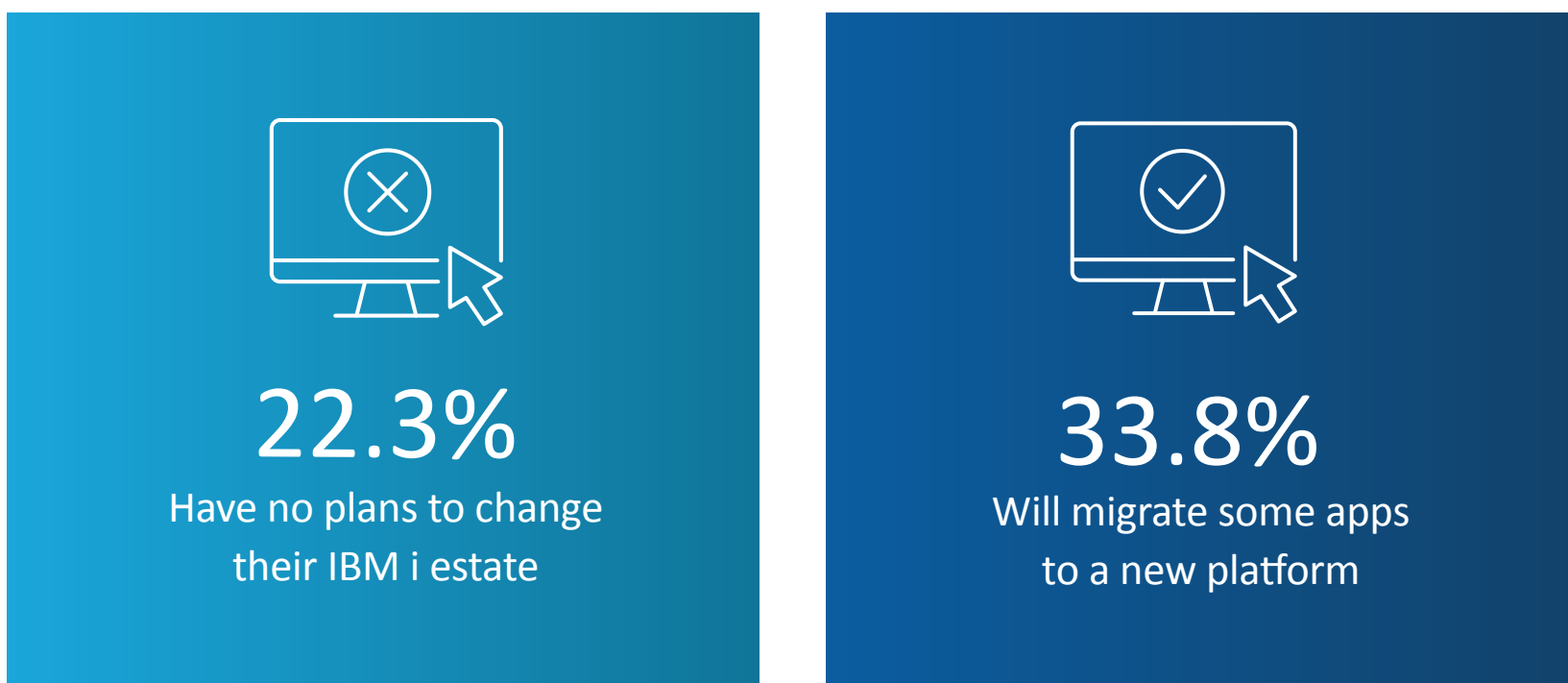
2. However, many business leaders find that connecting data held on IBM i to other parts of the IT estate is problematic:
