By 2020, an estimated **37,200** new mainframe administration positions will emerge³, exacerbating legacy skills shortages and creating problems in the core.

The Skills Gap

With 84,000 mainframe positions expected to be vacant by 2020¹, **65%** of businesses are choosing to outsource their IT operations².



Mainframe Priorities

89% of businesses predict long-term viability of the mainframe, with cost reduction, data privacy and security, and applications availability the top 3 priorities⁶.



Investing in Talent

IBM has invested more than **\$10 million** in its Academic Initiative, reaching over 68,000 students in more than 1,000 universities and colleges in 67 countries⁴.
